PROGRAMS AND PARTICIPATION

Loudonville Public Library offers a variety of programming for its community along with public meeting spaces.

2025 by the numbers:

- **63,741** library visits
- **7,142** people attending programs
- **743** Summer Reading Program participants



CIRCULATION AND COMMUNITY

Loudonville Public Library strives to have a variety of library materials available to meet our patrons' needs.

2025 by the numbers:

- **165,958** library items checked out (physical and digital)
- **82** passive programs with **25,307** participants



THE DIGITAL DIVIDE

Loudonville Public Library provided **127,561** computer uses and **68,967** wireless sessions in 2025.

The Perrysville Branch opened in 2022. This 24-hour library kiosk provides library books, materials, and free Wi-Fi access to Perrysville and the surrounding community.

SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM

Loudonville Public Library strives to provide the best service we can to the underserved in our community.

In 2025, the library served **3,423** meals to local children in need through the Greater Cleveland Food Bank Summer Food Service Program.
